In commemoration of 100th anniversary of the Anti-Asian Vancouver race riots, media artist and filmmaker Karin Lee is creating two site specific video installations that question the official reports of the riots that took place in Vancouver between September 7-10th, 1907.

Shattered questions the relationship between immigration, labour and business while commenting on the phenomenon of globalization. The installation brings together two historic perspectives of the riots while locating it within contemporary Vancouver.

Shattered will be located in two locations along the riot route:

**Chinatown (524 Shanghai Alley) and
Japantown (451 Powell Street).**
